

Mighty No. 9 - "CALL" paper craft instruction

Recommended materials:

- paper ~160gsm (5-6 sheet)
- printer (with color...!)
- glue
- scissors
- knife
- cutting mat (optional)
- tweezers (optional)



-1-Print out the Mighty No. 9 Call paper craft. Read the Instruction first so you will understand how it's assembled.

-2-Roughly cut out all parts:


Score along all the dotted lines with a knife without cutting through the paper. This will make the folding process easier later.

Glue these parts on another layer of thick paper: A2, A3, H4



Now you can begin cutting out A2 and A3, and cut away those black thick lines too. Stick the A3s onto the A2s and bend A2 as shown below:



-6Cut out A1 and cut through the short lines on the left and right and the 'bottom' side (marked RED on the picture below). This is where other parts will be attached without glue later.

Pre-fold the flaps and glue them on the inside of the corresponding edges. I recommend to start with the small flaps on the 'cheeks' and the ones below the cut where the headphones will be attached later. Leave the upper part open:




Put A2/A3 into A1. The 'front' is where the cheekflaps are on A1. After that, glue the upper A1 flaps to their edges. (Tweezers are helpful to hold the flaps until they're glued together)



-8-Cut out one or more faces (F1-F8). Notice: the cheek-flaps have no dotted folding lines. Score the green marked lines and cut the red ones on the picture below! Also don't forget the cuts for the headphones on the sides:




-9-Fold and glue E6 according to this picture:




-10-

Cut and pre-fold the hair D1. Cut through the two lines on the back and check if E6 fits through them. Then glue all the flaps to their edges:




When the flaps of the F-parts and the head (A1) are glued, slide the face over the head and check if you can slide through both cuts with a knife. It's not wrong to make these cuts a bit bigger...



-12-When the hair... D1 is dry, it can be assembled without glue, that way the face can be exchanged:




-13-Cut through the red marked lines on B1:




-14-Cut out B1, pre-fold, and glue the ...panty-flaps to the edges. Also glue the long big flap to the opposing edge. The upper part should be open.


-15-Cut out B2, fold & glue the flap to the other side:




-16-Slide B2 into B1 and glue the short flaps of B1 onto B2. You can hold all 4 flaps until they're dry by placing a finger into B2.




-17-Fold & glue B4 according to this:







-18-Slide B4 over B1 while pushing the long flaps of B4 into the cuts in B1. This part should be pulled back up a little when connecting the arms.



-19- Fold and glue the legs G2. Glue the flap marked with an $^{\prime}X^{\prime}$ last:



-20-Fold and glue the arms G3. Start with the hands, then the side-flaps in pic 1. Bend the long flaps down (pic 2) and glue them together:




-21-Put the long arm-flaps through the side-cuts of the body B1, slide down body part B4 completely and it should look like this:



-22-

Cut out E1 (outside) & E2 (inside) exactly at these marked edges before you completely cut and glue them together:



-23-Align E1 + E2 at the previously marked edges and glue them together:



-24-

Cut through the two lines in the middle and check if you can slide part E6 through the cuts. Then glue the inner middle-part of E6 to E2 (inside) and let the 2 flaps of E6 stick out.

-25-

Glue the two top flaps of E1 to their edges.

-26-

Cut out E5 and glue the long flap to the opposing side just like the body part B2. Fold all other flaps to the outside.


-27-

Glue the side of E5 with 4 flaps to E2 (inside).





Fold and glue E3. Cut E4 into three parts before you glue it to the inside of E3, so you can align the parts better:

Connect the top flap of E3 to the top of E1. When it's dry, put some glue on the remaining flaps of E3 and the 3 flaps of E5 and connect them all...





While the hair is drying.... cut out the boots G1 and connect all flaps to the edges. They should fit onto the legs (G2) without falling off.





Fold D3 and glue it together (2x). Glue the red side-flaps first:

Cut out D2 and cut through the 2 lines on the white part, and the 3 small lines on the red part. Then attach D3 as shown and glue D2 on the red marked spots:

The two flaps of the hair part E6 should fit through D2 and the hair D1. You can glue it all together, or leave it detachable:




-34-Cut out the Headphone parts C1, C2, C3, C4. Glue C2 and C3 together:






-35-Fold the remaining C2/C3 flaps and the C1 flaps to the inside a little, then glue them together:



-36-Fold C4 in the middle and glue it together. Then bend it and fold the flaps to the inside:



-37-Glue C1 to the sides of C4:



-38-Now you can assamble "Call"!





-39Cut out the base-parts H1-H5. Cut through the lines on H3 and make sure H4 fits through them. Don't glue H3+H4, it will be adjustable later:


Fold and glue all flaps of the base-plate H1 and cut through the two lines above the Mighty No. 9 logo.


Fold & glue all flaps of the base-reinforcement parts H2 and glue H1 and H2 together. Leave the two cuts in H1 free!



-42-Assemble H5. Push down the long flap with something like scissors until it's glued together:




-43-When assembling H3 and H4, the areas on H3 marked with 'X' should be hidden behind H4. Now put glue in the center of the non-marked areas of H3 (not on H4) and glue it onto H5:

Fold the flaps of H3 and H5 to the inside and pull them through the 2 cuts of H1. After that, unfold the flaps:



-45-The part with H4 goes inside the hair and shoud hold E5. Adjust the height of H4 and it's done!
